Local Area Network of NITT An overview

Local area network of NIT, Trichy is revamped and upgraded with 100 Mbps fiber optic connectivity. A no. of new servers have been added which caters to the various requirements of staff and students as follows:

Web server which contains details about academic programmes and activities of various departments, curriculum, syllabus, rules and regulations for various courses, advertisements and tender notices, alumni data base. The web server has also provision for controlled access to classified information through login names and pass word.

E-mail server which supports the delivery of emails to individuals and groups with less effort. The group mail id includes faculty@nitt.edu which enables notices and announcements to be sent to all the faculty.

Internet server which is used by both students and students for browsing, downloading files, chatting, video conferencing, exchange of email and submission of on line applications for higher studies. NITT has subscribed for on-line journals from IEEE and Elsevier. These journals are accessed by the students and staff through the internet server to carry out their research work efficiently. The internet server is also used for delivery of lectures by experts from academia and industry through video conferencing. Video conferencing is also used for conducting interviews. This includes interviews conducted for our students for placement and training as well as the interviews conducted by NITT for recruiting new staff members.

Silver server which has an electronic notice board which is used for displaying various notices and exchange of ideas between like minded people on different topics including sports, politics, campus life, employment, training and higher studies.

Delta server which has e-books, on-line learning resources including tutorials, guizzes and puzzles, content for on-line music

Data base server which gives details about examination results, mess bill arrears, salary and income tax details about staff members.

MIS server which has modules for Students Admissions, Fees, Scholarship & Administration Academic Department Management Financial Accounting and Budget Human Resources Management, Pay Roll and Pension Central Purchases, Stores and **Distribution Management and Hostel Management**
