ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO M.Sc. PROGRAMMES

Minimum of 60% marks or 6.5 CGPA in the qualifying examination, for OC / OBC and 55% aggregate marks or equivalent CGPA of 6.0 for SC/ST candidates. Final semester students can also apply provided their final marks are made available on or before 15th September, 2010. Such candidates may be considered for provisional admission. However, these candidates must have successfully passed with 60% mark in one to four semesters of B.Sc. or two years of bachelor's degree in science on the date of application and the application must include attested copies of the mark lists and bonafide certificate from the Head of the Institution in the prescribed format. Any candidate admitted provisionally, subject to his/her producing provisional certificate and mark lists as proof of having satisfied the eligibility criteria, shall have to discontinue the course, if he/she does not produce the provisional certificate and mark lists on or before 15th September, 2010. Such candidates will not be eligible for any refund of fees paid by him/her.

Reservation: Government of India reservation policy will be followed for OBC / SC / ST and Physically Handicapped Candidates.

How to apply?

Candidates applying for M.Sc. programmes can apply through the downloaded application form only. Downloadable application form and information brochure are available at www.nitt.edu. The filled up application form along with enclosures and a non refundable registration fee of Rs.300/- (Rs.100/- for SC/ST/ Persons with Disabilities) by means of Demand Draft drawn not earlier than 17th May, 2010 in favour of “**Director, National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli- 620 015**” payable at **Tiruchirappalli** should reach **Dean (Academic Programme), National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli-620015, Tamil Nadu** on or before **11th June, 2010**. The candidates are requested to write their name on the reverse side of the draft.
