She studied B.Arch in School of Architecture and Planning, Anna University, Chennai and did her UG thesis on Urban Rejuvenation of bus stand and market area of Nagercoil under the guidance of Ar. T. Vennila. During her UG, she came across unique building experiments in Auroville and was drawn by Mother's vision for a sustainable township. Her thirst to learn more about sustainable and earth architecture landed her in an internship and work in Auroville with Ar. Anupama Kundoo and a two-week hands-on AVD workshop by Ar. Satprem Maini in Auroville Earth Institute. She also showed keen interest in vernacular architecture from early on and participated in a 5-day workshop by Dr. Benny Kuriakose. The Tsunami of 2004 took her to Gandhigram for a few months as a volunteer for Disaster Management Unit when she visited Tsunami affected villages along the coast from Cuddalore to Colachel with the team. During this time she also had a chance to do a project with alternative (CSEB) construction as architectural consultant for Payir NGO in Trichy which helped her understand earth as a material better. She further pursued M.Arch in Texas A&M University, College Station USA with scholarship. She took up sustainable redesign of Hurricane affected public housing in New Orleans for as final project under the guidance of Dr. Robin Abrams. Health care design studio in TAMU led her to work in healthcare architecture in HGA, Los Angeles as medical planner. She worked on a few hospital projects including Lucille Packard Children's Hospital at Stanford. With support from HGA, she successfully earned "LEED AP" from GBCI, USA. After working 4 yrs in the city of Angels, she decided to return to India to serve her country. She then started teaching with a brief stint in Sigma college of Architecture, and then joined her alma mater, SAP Anna University, as Assistant Professor. During this time she did many rural studios and visited several villages with Prof. Muthulakshmi, etc. She participated in INTACH and NCSHS events which helped her in understanding historic buildings and conservation. She also engaged students in hands on experiences through workshops and several visits to Auroville, etc. Her love for environment (and inspired by CTC zero kuppai movement) led her to initiate Source Segregation of Waste in her college campus (with the support of SAP administration) as well as her in residential neighbourhood in Chennai. After serving in SAP Anna University for 7 years, she joined NIT Trichy in 2020 as Assistant professor. She was inducted to the Horticulture Advisory Committee as its Convener and was part of the team behind making of the campus's first Miyawaki forest in 2021. She has served as Faculty coordinator of Rotaract club of SAP and Animal Welfare club, NIT and a volunteer of SPICMACAY (TAMU, UCLA, Chennai), CTC's Clean up movements, Ainthinai Plantation works, Payir and more. At her leisure, she explores carnatic music, yoga, martial arts, running, swimming, cycling, trekking, zero waste lifestyle, gardening and loves to travel to new places.
