**ADMISSION INFORMATION BROCHURE FOR M.Sc. PROGRAMME  
(2016-17)**

**General:**

1. National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli invites applications from eligible Indian citizens for admission into various M.Sc. programmes offered in the Department of Physics, Chemistry and Computer Applications for the academic year 2016-2017. The M.Sc. programmes offered and eligible bachelor of science degree required for admissions are given below:

1.	M.Sc. (Physics)	(i) B.Sc.(Physics/Applied Physics/Applied Sciences) (ii) B.S.(Physics) (iii) B.Sc. Hons.(Physics) (iv) B.Sc.Ed.(Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics)
2.	M.Sc. (Chemistry)	B.Sc. Chemistry with Mathematics as one of the ancillary subjects
3.	M.Sc. (Computer Science)	(i) B.Sc.(Computer Science)/ B.Sc.(Information Technology)/ B.C.A. (ii) B.Sc.(Applied Sciences) with Mathematics and Computer Science (10+2+3 scheme) from a recognized university (iii) Any Bachelor's degree in science (10+2+3) from a recognized university with at least 6 papers in Computer Science and 2 papers in Mathematics under semester system or at least 3 papers in Computer Science and 1 paper in Mathematics under Annual System.

2. Candidates who have already passed their qualifying degree examination or who have appeared/are appearing for the final semester/year examination in 2016 are eligible to apply.
3. There is no stipend for the candidates admitted to M.Sc. programmes.

**ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO M.Sc. PROGRAMMES:**

1. Candidates should have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks or 6.5 CGPA (on a 10-point scale) in the qualifying degree examination for OC/OBC candidates [55% aggregate marks or 6.0 CGPA (on a 10-point scale) for SC/ST/PWD candidates] for admission to all M.Sc. programmes.
2. Those candidates who have appeared/are appearing for final semester/year examination, provisional admission is permitted provided their final marks are made available on or before 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2016.
3. Conversion from CGPA to percentage or vice versa given by individual institute will not be considered/allowed.

4. Any candidate admitted provisionally shall produce the provisional/degree certificate and all mark lists in original on or before 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2016. Else, their admission shall stand cancelled automatically. For such candidates refund will be made as per the norms applicable to the institute.

**Reservation:** Government of India reservation policy will be followed for OBC / SC / ST and Persons with Disability (PWD).

**OBC certificate:** OBC certificate must have been obtained on or after **01.04.2016** as per the prescribed format given in Annexure-I.

### How to apply?

1. Application form and information brochure can be downloaded from [www.nitt.edu](http://www.nitt.edu). Candidates can apply only through the downloaded application form.
2. The duly filled-in application form should be accompanied with attested copies of the following certificates :
  - (i) All Mark lists,
  - (ii) Transfer certificate
  - (iii) Degree/Provisional certificate (Course Completion/Bonafied certificate from the Head of the Institution where he/she last studied for result awaiting candidates),
  - (iv) Community certificate (if applicable),
  - (v) PWD certificate (if applicable) and
  - (vi) The registration fee is Rs.500/- for OC/OBC and Rs.200/- for SC/ST/PWD candidates. The payment should be made only through **State Bank Collect (SB Collect)**. The link for SB Collect payment is :

3. The candidate needs to pay the registration fee before filling the application form.
4. The registration fee is non-refundable.
5. Application forms completed in all respects along with the printout of the registration fee payment proof should reach "**The Chairperson (PG Admission), Office of the Dean (Academic), National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli - 620015, Tamil Nadu**" before **5:00 p.m** on or before **27<sup>th</sup> May 2016** in a sealed cover super-scribing "**Application for M.Sc. Programme**" by registered post or speed post.
6. Office of the Dean Academic, National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli is not responsible for the non-receipt of applications sent by post or by courier or late receipt of applications due to postal delay or for any reason whatsoever.
7. **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED.**

## SELECTION PROCEDURE:

1. Selection will be based on the marks obtained in entrance test conducted by NITT and the qualifying degree examination marks.
2. The entrance test for all the M.Sc. programmes will be conducted on **19<sup>th</sup> June 2016** from **10.30 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.** at NIT Tiruchirappalli.
3. **Admit card will be sent to the eligible candidates well before the date of entrance test and also the eligible candidates list for the entrance test will be displayed in [www.nitt.edu](http://www.nitt.edu).**

## Original Certificates to be produced at the time of Admission:

1. Admission letter received from NIT, Tiruchirappalli
2. Degree/provisional certificate
3. Consolidated Grade or mark sheet of qualifying degree examinations
4. Course completion/Bonafied certificate for result awaiting candidates
5. Transfer certificate issued by the institute last studied
6. Migration certificate
7. OBC certificate issued on or after 01.04.2016 by the competent authority, if applicable
8. SC/ST certificate issued by the competent authority, if applicable
9. Certificate for PWD candidates issued by the Medical Board notified under PWD Act.
