

SPOT ADMISSION for M.Tech. 2014

Spot admission for the vacant seats in various M.Tech. programmes at National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli, for the academic year 2014-15, will be held as per the following schedule:

Eligibility:

Indian Nationals who have passed the prescribed qualifying examinations with a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of at least 6.5 in 10 point scale Grading System or not less than 60% marks in the aggregate (taking into account of the marks scored in all subjects of all the University examinations conducted during the entire prescribed period of the degree programme) with a valid GATE score (2013 or 2014) are eligible to appear for SPOT Admission 2014 at NIT, Tiruchirappalli. For SC/ST candidates, the minimum prescribed qualification shall be CGPA of 6.0 or 55% marks.

Note: Those who have taken admission already through CCMT-2014 process in any institute and wish to participate in the Spot Admission at NIT, Tiruchirappalli have to cancel their admission before appearing for Spot Admission.

Registration for Spot Admission: The eligible candidates should register for Spot Admission through ONLINE portal before 4:30 p.m. on 22.07.2014. **Such online registered candidates (registered during 21.07.2014 to 22.07.2014) only will be considered for Spot Admission.** After successful completion of registration, a printable (pdf) version of Spot Admission Registration Form will be generated. Candidates who have registered will have to physically report to National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli at 9:00 a.m. on 24.07.2014 along with printout of their Spot Admission Registration Form and all original certificates.

Tentative Vacancy position will be displayed in our website latest by 10:30 a.m. 20.07.2014

Selection Process: Seat allotment and eligibility criteria will be as per CCMT-2014 procedure.

The eligible candidates who have registered through online for Spot Admission at National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli should be present **in person** on 24.07.2014 at 9:00 a.m. for Spot Admission. Any registered candidate coming after 9:00 a.m. will not be considered for further process.

Instructions:

In case the seat allotment is confirmed for the candidate,

1. He/she will have to make a payment of Rs.500/- (Rs. 300/- for SC/ST) through DD drawn in favour of “**The Director, National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli**” payable at **Tiruchirappalli** as processing fee at the time of collecting the seat allotment letter on 24.07.2014.
2. He/she has to pay the institute fee and produce the following documents in original for verification and submission, failing which his/her seat allotment, will be cancelled and that seat will be allotted **at once** to the next registered candidate in the list.
 - i. Photo ID proof of the candidate
 - ii. Printout of the Spot Registration Form
 - iii. Transfer Certificate issued from the institute last attended
 - iv. Migration Certificate
 - v. GATE score card (2013/ 2014)
 - vi. Statement of marks or Grades obtained in the qualifying Examination
 - vii. Degree / Provisional Certificate.
 - viii. Course completion certificate for result awaiting candidates
 - ix. Class X (High School) Board Certificate as proof of date of birth.
 - x. Certificate of category (OBC / SC / ST), if applicable, issued by the competent authority as per the format given in the Annexure-I (OBC certificate should have been issued on or after 1.4.2014)
 - xi. Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PWD) issued by competent authorities
 - xii. One set of attested copy of all the documents listed above.
 - xiii. Recent colour photographs – 4 Nos. (2 Passport size and 2 stamp size)
3. The class work commences on **06.08.2014**

Institute fee: The candidate, who has obtained seat allotment, has to pay the institute fee of Rs.43,300/- (Rs.8,300/- for SC/ST candidates) on the same day in the form of DD drawn in favour of “**The Director, National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli**” payable at **Tiruchirappalli**.

Hostel Fee: The Hostel admission will be provided from **03.08.2014** onwards. So the candidates are advised **NOT** to bring any belongings during SPOT Admission (that is, on 24.07.2014). All those who seek admission in the hostels are requested to bring a separate DD drawn in favour of “**The Chief Warden, NIT, Tiruchirappalli** ”, payable at Tiruchirappalli for a sum of **Rs. 21,800/-** towards the Hostel and mess fees. **The hostel fee will be collected from 03.08.2014** onwards.

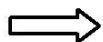

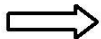
