1.0 Brief Information about the Institute

The National Institute of Technology (formerly Regional Engineering College) Tiruchirappalli was established as a joint venture of the Government of India and the Government of Tamil Nadu in 1964 to bring out world-class engineers who will meet to the growing technological needs of the nation. NIT-T has been declared an institution of national importance by the National Institute of Technology Act 2007 by the parliament.

2.0 Vision, Mission, Core Values and Goals

NIT Tiruchirappalli, through its Vision, Mission and Core Values, defines herself as:

- An Indian institution with world standards
- A global pool of talented students, committed faculty and conscientious researchers
- Responsive to real-world problems and, through a synergy of education and research, engineer a better society

2.1 Vision

To be a university globally trusted for technical excellence where learning and research integrate to sustain society and industry.

2.2 Mission

- To offer undergraduate, postgraduate, doctoral and modular programmes in multi-disciplinary / inter-disciplinary and emerging areas.
- To create a converging learning environment to serve a dynamically evolving society.
- To promote innovation for sustainable solutions by forging global collaborations with academia and industry in cutting-edge research.
- To be an intellectual ecosystem where human capabilities can develop holistically

2.3 Core Values:

3.0 Goals

International Accreditation and Ranking in tertiary education largely guide goal-setting. The perception built by the stakeholders, crucially influence the process of repositioning. Benchmarking with global universities who are in the top 200 in world rankings in terms of teaching, innovation and research, funding and internationalization. Hence, the need to set the following goals:

- Attracting top talent and global collaborations
- Building world-class research infrastructure to facilitate multi-/inter-/trans-disciplinary research
- Initiatives towards financial sustainability
- Social outreach activities of national / international importance
- Top 10 in India ranking in Engineering Discipline
- Top 500 in World Ranking in five years

4.0 Administration

The NITs were carved out of 17 Regional Engineering Colleges across India and are now the fully funded institutions under the Central Government with Deemed to be University status. The move was intended to make the institutions centers of excellence and being developed as autonomous and flexible academic institutions of excellence to meet the sweeping changes taking place in the industrial environment in post liberalized India and also the rapidly changing scene of technical education globally. NIT Tiruchirappalli is one among the 30 NITs and its basic structure of organisation, functions and powers of the Institute are briefed in the MOA of the Institute. A large number of rules, regulations, ordinances, policy decisions etc. have been formulated by the Board of Governors, Senate and other authorities of the Institute for regulating the day-to-day work of the expanded activities of the Institute.

5.0 Academics

The National Institute of Technology (formerly Regional Engineering College) Tiruchirappalli was established as a joint venture of the Government of India and the Government of Tamil Nadu in 1964 to produce world-class engineers who will cater to the growing technological needs of the nation. The institute was granted Deemed University status with the approval of the UGC / AICTE and Government of India in 2003 and renamed as National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli (NIT-T). NIT-T has been declared as institution of national importance by National Institute of Technology act 2007. The move was intended to provide teaching and research in the branches of engineering, science, technology and management for the advancement of teaching and research. NIT Tiruchirappalli is one among them and its basic structure, functions and powers are briefed in the NIT act 2007 and NIT statues 2009. National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli has carved a mark on the National scene last year by being ranked first among all the NITs and 12th among all the technical institutes in the country by the Institute Ranking framework (NIRF) of the Government of India. National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli also won the prestigious CII-AICTE best industry linked institute by competing with other IITs, NITs and IIITs. The institute also received national level awards from FICCI for social responsibility and from ASSOCHAM for the best institute to used

ICT tools in education. The institute also received High impact Entrepreneurship Campus Award jointly awarded by the Ministry of Skills Development and Entrepreneurship. As matter of fact, among the top reputed technical institutes of the country, National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli has reached the pinnacle in academic reforms and research. The academic conclave conducted in 2015, has set the Institute on a road to major academic transformation. The senate of the institute has approved the deliberations of the Conclave and has endorsed the introduction of flexible curriculum, minor specializations, flipped class rooms based on course plans and new evaluation models. The flexible curriculum designed and implemented by National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli has been recognized as a model curriculum by NIT council. The institute also undertook a major peer review process by bringing in experts from IITs, leading industries and other able educationalists. The critical comments of the reviewers were quite helpful in striving further to reach global standards.

6.0 Research & Consultancy

Our campus is witnessing an exponential growth in R&D activities. Apart from a large consultancy work undertaken by our engineering departments, academic research gains its momentum day by day. Nearly 200 research scholars are undergoing their Ph.D in various fields in all the departments. We have introduced M.S by Research in all engineering departments in order to cater the aspiring engineers directly to pursue their research. Young faculty members holding doctoral degree are offered a seed money of Rs. 50,000/- to start their research. Papers have been published by our faculty members and research scholars in different refereed journals of international and national repute. Research papers have been presented in various conferences, seminars and symposia held at national and international levels. Seminars, conferences and symposia at national level were organized by various departments of our institute.

Our institute has signed MOUs with industries and institutions in and abroad to promote collaborative research and consultancies. MOU signed with BHEL, our neighbouring industrial campus provides an opportunity for our young researchers to use the infrastructure in BHEL. BHEL offers scholarships for such

research scholars pursuing PhD and MS. The MUO signed with our then parent Bharadhidasan University looks forward collaborative research activities to be undertaken in both campuses. Another MOU has been signed with NIMS Japan for the collaborative research in the area of nanotechnology. MOUs with IBM and HP, leading software industries have been executed. HP has offered a Chair position to monitor the ongoing HP projects undertaken by our students. Apart from the ongoing projects, our faculty members have obtained major projects funded by DST, CSIR and AICTE.

7.0 Central Library

The Institute has a modern Central Library with more than two and half lakh of documents consisting of Technical books, reports, standards, CD-ROMS, Audio Visual Educational Cassettes and back volumes of journals. The library subscribes to 164 periodicals (print) plus 7000+ e-Journals and 2000+ e-books besides a holding of 17690 back volumes of journals. The library also contains 16,750 books in the Book Bank scheme.

Digital Knowledge Centre has been established with 35 Ubuntu Computer systems with internet connection. WiFi facility has been provided for laptop users. CCTV cameras have been fixed in the Central Library and the entire building is under camera surveillance. RFID Technology of Document Identification and Library Security System have been implemented for the library functions and services.

8.0 OCTAGON (Computer Center)

The hallmark of this campus is the OCTAGON - Computer Center. This center serves the campus-wide LAN in close association with the user departments. This LAN caters to 1500 users across the campus at the same time and has a 10 Gbps fiber optic backbone. It also acts as a resource centre to supplement classroom instructions with laboratory sessions. The OCTAGON accommodates the central computing facilities; it has a server room with Windows 27 & Linux 18 high-end servers and 200 high-end computers; its laboratories include four labs; a Printer room equipped with high-speed A3 and A4 network Laser Printers (colour and mono);

a Library for software, CBTs and manuals; Conference and Seminar facilities, a CAD/CAM Centre with 22 high-end workstations and an in-house maintenance facility. The centre is maintained by the Computer Support Group (CSG). It has centralized 2 x 60 kVA redundant Uninterrupted Power Supply with 200 kVA standby Power Generators and Central Air Conditioning.

A new Annex building with an additional capacity of 198 computers has come up next to Octagon to meet the additional requirements. The Annex building has two labs, each with 99 computers. A second annexure with 4 laboratories is coming up during this academic year.

8.1 Services Offered

- Octagon is kept open 24 X 7.
- Internet Access via 100 Mbps (1:1) leased line from Software Technology Park of India (STPI) and 1 Gbps National Knowledge Network (NKN)
- Internet (WWW, EMAIL, DNS) services and Intranet Services (MIS, BOOKS)
- It supports UG / PG Admission counseling every year.
- Continuing Education Programme in computer skills.
- Recruitment & Apprentices for the institute.
- This centre serves the campus – wide LAN (Wired as well as wireless) in close association with the user departments.
- Wired Campus Networking having 10 Gbps Fibre Optic Backbone, Gigabit Routing Switch and 1/10 Gbps Managed Switches a Departments.
- A Wi-fi facility available at Hostel Zones and select pockets of the campus. Very soon the facility would be available throughout the campus.
- Network security is provided through two UTM appliances with failover option (Sonic wall NSA 8500) AND two Email Security appliances (Sonic Wall Es8300). User authentication for browsing the Internet is linked with ADS.

- NIT-T hosts two inter-collegiate festivals namely Festember (Cultural) and Pragyam (Technical). It also hosts an inter-departmental festival namely, NITTFEST (Cultural). These festivals find huge student participation from all over the country.
- The institute has a total campus area of about 800 acres. The major student amenities like Hostels, Hospital, Post Office, fully computerized State Bank of India (with ATMs), Stationery stores, Canteens, Cafeterias, Swimming pool, Shopping centre, etc., are available within the campus.
