

Biographical Statement of the speaker

A. Suresh Canagarajah is the Edwin Erle Sparks Professor of Applied Linguistics, English, and Asian Studies and the Director of the Migration Studies Project at Pennsylvania State University. He is an S. T. Lee Visiting Fellow at the School of Advanced Studies, University of London and a fellow of the Stellensbosch Institute for Advanced Studies, Cape Town, South Africa. He is honoured by TESOL International as one of the top fifty scholars who has shaped the field of TESOL (2016). Cangarajah has won several academic accolades including the Presidential Excellence award for Distinguished Scholarship and Research (2004) from Baruch College, the City University of New York for his commitment to excellence in teaching and outstanding academic achievements. He has authored six books and has co-edited four books including the Routledge Handbook of Migration and Language (2017). His notable works include A Geopolitics of Academic Writing (2002), Critical Academic Writing and Multilingual Students (2002).
