The number of seats for the Capacity Building Programme is restricted to 30 candidates (10 from Tiruchirappalli, 10 from Tamil Nadu and 10 from outside the state). The selection of candidates will be done as per the ICSSR guidelines.

Procedure to apply

Interested faculty members can download the application form available at www.nit.edu and send the completed form through Speed Post to the Course Director. The last date for the submission of application is 30th July 2019. Selected candidates will be informed through e-mail during the first week of August 2019. Since seats are limited, apply at the earliest.

Programme will be conducted from 19th (Monday) to 30th (Friday), August, 2019.

This Capacity Building Programme will be conducted on the said dates from 9.00 a.m. to 5.30 p.m., without any holiday on Saturday & Sunday.

There is no registration fee for the selected participants. Accommodation will be provided to all outstation participants at NIT Trichy guest house on a twin sharing basis. Travel allowances by the shortest distance (to and fro fare by AC III tire/AC Chair Car/Bus) will be reimbursed to the outstation participant as per ICSSR Guidelines.
