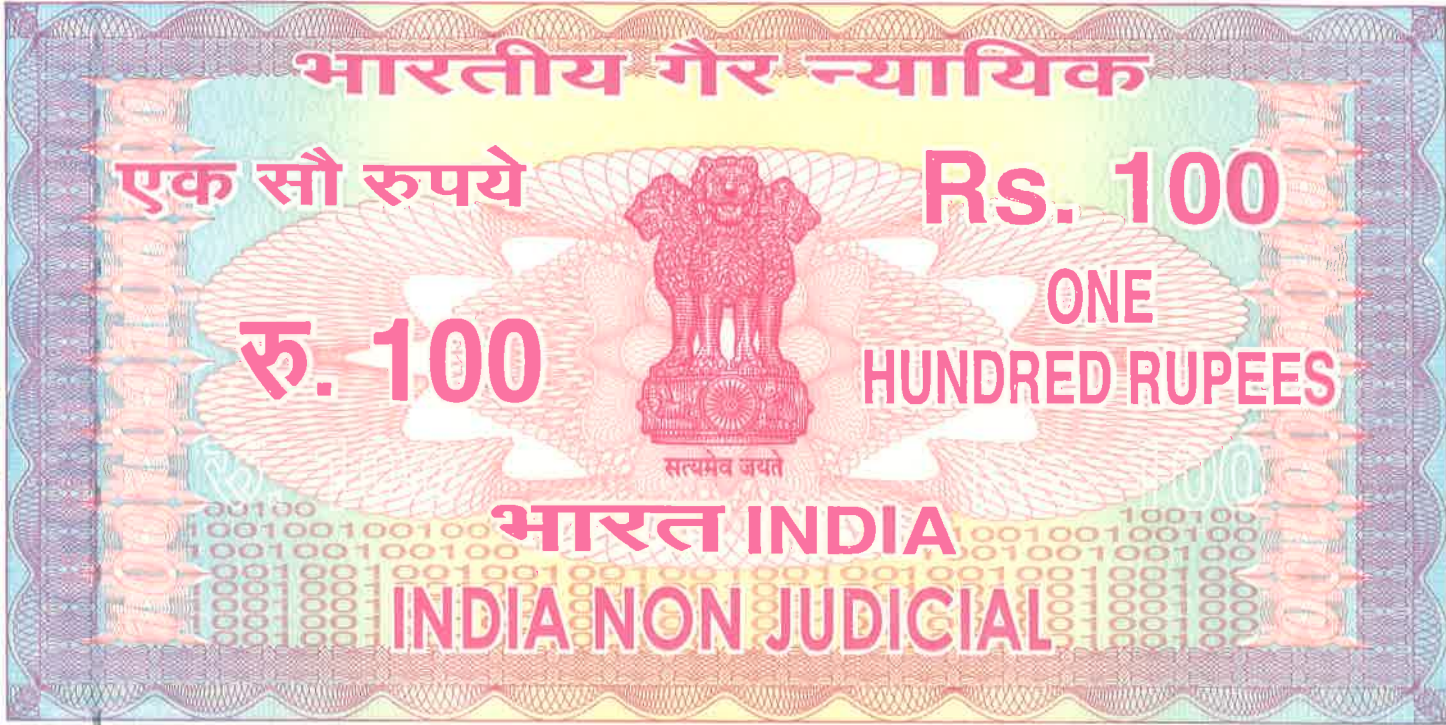

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**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**BETWEEN**

National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli

**AND**

Enerzinx India Private Limited

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is entered into on **06.07.2026** between National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli, hereinafter referred to as NIT, Tiruchirappalli, and Enerzinx India Private Limited, Velankani Tech Park, No. 43, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, South Wing, Block I, Electronic City, Phase – I, Hosur Road, Bangalore – 560100, Karnataka hereinafter referred to as Enerzinx.

**1. PREAMBLE**

National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli is a reputed institution of higher education and research, offering academic programs and promoting excellence in engineering, technology, sciences, and allied disciplines. The Institute is committed to developing competent technical and scientific manpower for the country through education, research, and innovation.

Enerzinx India Private Limited provides expert consulting services for electrical design and development of renewable energy projects and their grid integration. Enerzinx supports developers, generation owners, equipment manufacturers, and financial institutions, and has developed strong expertise in renewable energy engineering, training, research, and consultancy support.

National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli and Enerzinx India Private Limited mutually appreciate and recognize the efforts for improving quality of service in consultancy, research, development, laboratory development, and training programs. This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into for collaborative efforts in quality teaching, research, and consultancy.

## **2. PURPOSE**

The aim of this MoU is to establish a written understanding under which both parties may enter into collaborative programs and projects in areas of mutual interest.

## **3. AREAS OF COLLABORATION**

- i. Sharing scientific and technical knowledge in the power systems and renewable energy domain.
- ii. At the initial stage, Enerzinx will be offering a 3-credit program elective course for the PG power system students of National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli. The course will be delivered in a blended mode, with 70% conducted online and 30% offline, aimed at equipping students with essential industry relevant skills. An internal faculty from the Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering, nominated by HoD will be coordinating this course. Additionally, the course may be extended to other students on a case-by-case basis if required.
- iii. Providing opportunities to students of National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli for training and project activities at Enerzinx India Private Limited, from time to time.
- iv. Jointly organizing workshops, seminars, conferences, or similar academic and industry engagement programs.
- v. Sharing resources such as laboratories and libraries by students, engineers, or researchers of both organizations for projects and research work, subject to mutual consent.

## **4. AGREEMENT ON COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMMES**

Each collaboration undertaken by both parties shall describe in detail the following:

- i. The nature, scope, and timeline of the collaborative schedule.
- ii. The form and mechanism as may be agreed under Clause 3 above.
- iii. Any other provision as deemed necessary and agreed by both parties.

## **5. NODAL AUTHORITY**

The Nodal Officer from National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli shall be the Director or nominee, and the Nodal Officer from Enerzinx India Private Limited shall be the Director or nominee for all decisions, implementation, and concurrence.

## **6. FINANCING**

- i. Both parties agree that, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing, all costs, expenses, and financial obligations arising out of or in connection with the cooperation activities under this MoU shall be solely borne by Enerzinx. Food, accommodation and local transportation for personnel engaged in such activities shall be arranged and provided by the National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli.
- ii. Both parties shall conduct activities under this MoU subject to applicable laws, regulations, budget allocation, fund availability, and statutory authority of appropriate funds and personnel. Details of financing for each activity shall be established in writing before commencement.

## **7. DISPUTES SETTLEMENT**

Any dispute concerning the interpretation or application of this MoU shall be settled amicably through negotiation and mutual consent between the parties.

## **8. RISK INDEMNIFICATION**

Any expenses incurred due to medical emergencies or accidents involving students shall be borne by the Parent Institution. The Company shall bear any expenses incurred due to medical emergencies or accidents involving its faculty members. Both parties shall obtain appropriate insurance coverage to mitigate potential risks and liabilities.

## **9. DISCLAIMERS**

The students, faculty, and staff of National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli shall not be considered employees, whether borrowed or otherwise, of the second party, and vice versa. This MoU does not aim to achieve, guarantee, or create employment obligation

## **10. JURISDICTION**

The civil courts at Madurai (jurisdiction city) shall have sole jurisdiction to try and decide any dispute between the parties if the dispute is not settled by mutual consent.

## **11. MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION**

Either party may terminate the MoU at any time for valid reasons acceptable in writing to both parties, and the MoU shall be deemed terminated six months after the date of written notification or the date of expiry of the MoU, whichever is earlier. In the event of premature termination, all rights and obligations of both parties shall cease automatically, except those covered by written contracts, such as ongoing collaborative activities that cannot be cancelled. The parties may amend the MoU by mutual written consent, specifying the date of entry into force of such amendments.

## **12. IMPLEMENTATION AND ACTION PLAN**

- i. National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli and Enerzinx India Private Limited shall endeavour to finalize details of implementation and action plans for collaborative efforts for the academic year 2026-2027.
- ii. This MoU shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of 5 years. unless renewed or discontinued earlier by mutual consent.
- iii. Representatives nominated by both parties may be designated separately for implementation of this MoU, as mutually agreed in writing.
- iv. Financial commitments related to joint activities shall be decided mutually by both parties.
- v. Progress of the MoU shall be reviewed periodically by the Director of Enerzinx India Private Limited and the Director of National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli or their nominees.
