## Admission Information: B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary Stage) at NIT, Tiruchirappalli (Academic Year 2025–26)

### Salient Points

- The **National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli** has introduced the **B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary Stage)** programme starting from the academic year 2024–25.
- This is a **four-year integrated Dual-Major programme**, with one major in **Education** and the other in one of the following three disciplines: **Physics, Chemistry, or Mathematics**.
- **Allotment of the disciplinary major** will be based on the candidate's performance in the **National Common Entrance Test (NCET)** conducted by the **National Testing Agency (NTA)**.
- Candidates who have completed **Class XII in the Science stream**, with **Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics** as subjects, are **eligible to apply** for any of the three disciplinary majors offered.
- Applicants must have appeared any combination of three Domain-Specific Subjects chosen from: **Chemistry, Mathematics / Applied Mathematics, Physics, Biology / Biological Studies / Biotechnology / Biochemistry, and Computer Science / Informatics Practices** as their **domain-specific subjects** in the NCET.
- A minimum of **50% aggregate marks** (or equivalent grade) in **Class XII** is required for eligibility.
- **Admission will be based on the total NCET score**, which includes scores in all **seven components**: Language 1, Language 2, Teaching Aptitude, General Test, and the three chosen domain-specific subjects.
- Candidates **absent in any of the seven NCET components** will **not be considered for admission**.
- **NIT, Tiruchirappalli** will conduct the **admission counselling** for the B.Sc. B.Ed. programme.
- During submission, candidates must submit **separate application** for the disciplinary major (Physics, Chemistry, or Mathematics)
- Applications must be submitted **online** (the submission schedule will be announced shortly).
- A **non-refundable application fee of ₹500/- per discipline** must be paid at the time of application.
- Candidates are advised to **regularly check the application portal** for updates on **seat allotment** and take necessary action within the given timelines.
- Those who are **offered a seat** must pay the **Seat Acceptance Fee online** within the stipulated time to confirm admission.
- A total of **50 seats** are available in the programme, **distributed across the three disciplinary majors**. The **seat matrix** is provided in **Table 1**

### About NIT, Tiruchirappalli

The National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli (formerly known as Regional Engineering College, Tiruchirappalli) was established in 1964 as a joint venture between the Government of India and the Government of Tamil Nadu. The institute was envisioned to produce world-class engineers to meet the country's evolving technological demands. In 2003, it was granted Deemed University status by the University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), and the Government of India, and was renamed as National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli (NIT-T). In line with this vision, NIT, Tiruchirappalli has broadened its academic scope beyond Engineering to include Sciences, Management, Humanities, Economics, and Entrepreneurship. The launch of the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) is a testament to the institute’s commitment to inclusive, future-ready, and professional education. With a vibrant student body of nearly 12,000 students across undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral programmes, NIT, Tiruchirappalli is among the most dynamic and diverse academic institutions in India.

### **About the Programme**

NIT, Tiruchirappalli is proud to pioneer the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) within the NIT, system - a first of its kind. This four-year dual-major undergraduate programme is designed in alignment with the objectives of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and the guidelines of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), Ministry of Education, Government of India. The programme awards a B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary Stage) degree, combining a strong foundation in Education with in-depth disciplinary knowledge in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, and Economics.

The ITEP at NIT, Tiruchirappalli aims not only to prepare professionally qualified teachers for the evolving school education system in India but also to provide a rigorous grounding in the chosen academic discipline. This will enable graduates to pursue advanced studies and professional careers in their subject areas, in addition to the teaching profession.

Structured across eight semesters, the four-year B.Sc. B.Ed. programme is a dual-major degree, with one major in Education and the other in one of the selected disciplines: Physics, Chemistry, or Mathematics. The curriculum also focuses on nurturing values of social responsibility and equipping student-teachers with 21<sup>st</sup> century skills such as critical and creative thinking, problem-solving, ethical reasoning, and effective communication.

The B.Sc.B.Ed. is a credit-based programme, offering students the flexibility to progress at their own pace while maintaining required academic standards for satisfactory performance.

## Admission Process

Admission to the ITEP will be through the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA). The NCET scores will serve as the basis for selection. The seat matrix for the three disciplinary majors offered under the B.Sc. B.Ed. programme at NIT, Tiruchirappalli is provided in Table 1.

## Eligibility Requirement (ER) and Minimum Educational Qualification (MEQ)

For the 2025 admissions, many ITEP aspirants have chosen alternative Domain-Specific Subjects such as Biology / Biological Studies / Biotechnology / Biochemistry and Computer Science / Informatics Practices. To accommodate a broader range of subject combinations, the committee has recommended the following eligibility criteria for B.Sc. B.Ed. admissions through the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for 2025:

- 1. NCET Score:** Candidates must have a valid total score in NCET 2025, covering all seven test components:
  - Language 1
  - Language 2
  - Teaching Aptitude
  - General Test
  - Any combination of three Domain-Specific Subjects chosen from: Chemistry, Mathematics / Applied Mathematics, Physics, Biology / Biological Studies / Biotechnology / Biochemistry, and Computer Science / Informatics Practices.
- 2. Educational Qualification:** A pass in the Higher Secondary (Plus Two) examination or its equivalent from any recognized board in India, with the following subjects: Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, and either Biology or Computer Science.
- 3. Minimum Marks Requirement:**
  - Candidates belonging to GEN, GEN-EWS, and OBC-NCL categories must have secured a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.
  - Candidates belonging to SC, ST, and PwD categories must also have secured a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.
- 4. NCET Qualification:** The candidate must be qualified in NCET 2025 conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).



In addition,

1. A candidate should have appeared in the Class XII (or equivalent) examination for the first time in either 2023, 2024 or 2025, with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics as compulsory subjects.
2. Candidates should have been born on or after October 1, 2000. Five years of age relaxation is given to SC, ST, and PwD candidates, i.e., these candidates should have been born on or after October 1, 1995.

For candidates who meet the **Eligibility Requirements (ERs)**, **Minimum Educational Qualifications (MEQs)**, and other necessary criteria, **seat allotment will be made solely based on their NCET scores**, without any additional interview or written examination.

At the time of admission, all selected candidates must submit a **Physical Fitness Certificate** issued by a **registered medical practitioner**, in the **prescribed format** provided by NIT Tiruchirappalli. Additionally, candidates may be required to undergo a **Physical Fitness assessment** conducted by a **Medical Board constituted by the Institute**. If a candidate is deemed **medically unfit to pursue the programme**, the **admission is subject to cancellation**.

In cases where a qualifying board issues **only letter grades** without providing the corresponding **percentage of marks**, the candidate must obtain and submit a **certificate from the board indicating the equivalent percentage** at the time of seat acceptance. Failure to provide such a certificate will result in the matter being referred to NIT, Tiruchirappalli, whose **decision will be final and binding**.

### **Reservation of Seats**

Admission of **Indian nationals** under reserved categories is carried out in accordance with the prevailing **Government of India regulations**.

For each **disciplinary major**, a specific number of seats, as detailed in **Table 1**, is reserved for candidates belonging to various categories including **Scheduled Castes (SC)**, **Scheduled Tribes (ST)**, **Other Backward Classes – Non-Creamy Layer (OBC-NCL)**, **Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)**, and **Persons with Disabilities (PwD)**.

- Candidates applying under the **SC/ST category** must upload a valid **category certificate** issued by a **competent authority**, as specified in **Form - SC and ST**.
- Candidates applying under the **OBC-NCL or EWS category** must submit a valid certificate issued by a competent authority, in the format prescribed in **Form-OBC-NCL** or **Form-EWS**, respectively. The certificate must be issued **on or after April 1, 2025**. Additionally, candidates may be required to produce a valid certificate again at the time of **reporting to NIT, Tiruchirappalli**.
- Candidates seeking admission under the **PwD category** must submit a valid **disability certificate** (as per Annexure 2) or a **Unique Disability Identification (UDID) certificate**. Only candidates with **benchmark disabilities (40% or more impairment)**, regardless of the type of disability, are eligible for reservation. The disability must be certified by a **Government Medical Board**, and the candidate must be deemed medically fit to pursue the programme. The certificate should preferably follow **Form-PwD (II)**, **Form-PwD (III)**, or **Form-PwD (IV)**, as per the

*Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017.* NIT, Tiruchirappalli may also require the disability percentage to be **verified by a Medical Board** constituted by the Institute.

### Important Note:

The benefit of reservation is **subject to document verification**. If at any stage it is found that a candidate has submitted **false, forged, or incomplete documents** or provided **incorrect information** to claim reservation benefits, such a candidate will be **disqualified** from the admission process. If admission has already been granted, it shall be **cancelled immediately**.

### Application Procedure

Applications for admission to the **B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary Stage)** programme at NIT, Tiruchirappalli must be submitted **online through the** <https://nittadm.samarth.edu.in/>, along with the payment of a **non-refundable application fee of ₹500/-**.

Only candidates whose names appear in the **NCET 2025 Result List** are eligible to apply. Each candidate must submit **only one completed application form per discipline**.

Before beginning the application process, candidates are advised to **verify their personal and academic details** on the <https://nittadm.samarth.edu.in/>. In case of any discrepancies, they should contact the institute via email:

The list of documents to be uploaded during the application process is provided in **Annexure 3**.

Candidates may apply to one or more **disciplinary majors** under the B.Sc. B.Ed. programme, based on the **qualified domain-specific test papers** in NCET 2025 and subject to meeting the **Minimum Educational Qualifications (MEQs)** and **Eligibility Requirements (ERs)** of NIT, Tiruchirappalli.

### Admission Procedure

An applicant will be considered for admission **only to the disciplinary majors** mentioned in their application form. Seat allotment will be conducted through **three rounds of counseling**. If vacancies remain after these rounds, **additional rounds may be held** at the discretion of the Institute.

Candidates who receive a **seat allotment in any round** must **log in to the** <https://nittadm.samarth.edu.in/> within the stipulated time to take further action.

Upon receiving an allotment for the **first time**, the candidate will be required to pay the **Seat Acceptance Fee** through the online payment portal:

- ₹10,000/- for **General, OBC-NCL, and EWS** categories
- ₹5,000/- for **SC, ST, and PwD** categories

The SB Collect link will be communicated to the Shortlisted Candidates through e-mail

### Round-wise Counseling Process

- The **First Admission List** will be prepared based on the candidate's merit rank and disciplinary major filled in the application. The list will be published on or before a specified date (to be announced later). Candidates must log in to the portal to view their allotment status and pay the Seat Acceptance Fee by the announced deadline.
- If seats remain vacant, a **Second Admission List** will be published. Candidates must check the portal for updated seat allotment and pay the Seat Acceptance Fee within the specified timeframe.
- A **Third Admission List** will be generated if vacancies persist. Candidates allotted seats in this round must again log in to the portal and complete the Seat Acceptance Fee payment as per the given schedule.

### Withdrawal and Refund Policy

Candidates who wish to **withdraw** from the admission process after being allotted a seat may do so by logging into <https://nittadm.samarth.edu.in/> and selecting the "**Withdraw**" option. This option will remain available **up to the end of the second round of counseling**. Upon withdrawal, the Seat Acceptance Fee will be **refunded after deducting a processing fee of ₹1,000/-**.

### Final Admission and Reporting

After the final round of admissions, **offer letters** will be made available for download through the <https://nittadm.samarth.edu.in/>. Candidates who are allotted a seat must **report to NIT, Tiruchirappalli** on the specified date, carrying all **required original documents** as mentioned in the offer letter.

### Important Points to Note:

#### General Instructions and Important Guidelines

##### 1. Regular Updates:

Applicants are advised to regularly visit the **NIT, Tiruchirappalli website** and the <https://nittadm.samarth.edu.in/> for important updates. They must also check the <https://nittadm.samarth.edu.in/> for the status of their application and monitor their **registered e-mail** for official communications.

##### 2. Validity of Applications:

Applications that are **incomplete** or **not supported by valid documents** will be **rejected without prior intimation**. The **application fee** paid, if any, will **not be refunded** in such cases. Additionally, application forms for which the fee is **not received by NIT, Tiruchirappalli before the deadline** will not be considered for admission.



### 3. **Seat Allotment Process:**

Candidates **not allotted a seat in an earlier round** may still be considered in **subsequent rounds**, subject to availability. However, **failure to accept an allotted seat at any stage** will lead to **disqualification from further rounds** of the admission process.

### 4. **Strict Adherence to Timelines:**

The **last date for payment** of the seat acceptance fee in each round is **non-negotiable**. If the candidate **fails to accept the seat** or **does not make the required payment** within the stipulated time, the **allotment will be cancelled automatically**, and no further requests or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

### 5. **No Automatic Admission:**

Inclusion in the **NCET 2025 Result List** does **not guarantee admission**. Admissions will be made **purely on merit**, based on NCET scores, and **subject to seat availability** at NIT, Tiruchirappalli.

### 6. **Provisional Nature of Offer:**

All admission offers made during the seat allotment process shall be considered **provisional** until the candidate fulfills **all admission requirements and deadlines** as stipulated by NIT, Tiruchirappalli.

### 7. **Final Authority:**

In case of any interpretation, clarification, or issues not explicitly covered in this information brochure, the **decision of NIT, Tiruchirappalli** shall be **final and binding** on all applicants.

### 8. **Responsibility of NCET:**

The **National Testing Agency (NTA)** is solely responsible for conducting **NCET 2025**. Any queries, claims, or disputes relating to the examination must be directed to the NTA.

#### Person with Disability (PwD) Category

Benefits of concessionary fees and reservations would be given only to those who have benchmark disability i.e., not less than 40% impairment irrespective of the type of disability. Candidates should submit a certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer / Civil Surgeon / Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution. The certificate should be preferably in the format given in Form 1 or Form 2, or Form 3 in the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 available at
