English	M.A.	English & LAQP01	 Candidates seeking admission to M.A. degree programme shall have First class (60% or above of aggregate marks or 6.5 CGPA) in B.A. in English Literature / ELT / Linguistics from any recognized university / college. SC / ST / PwD candidates seeking admission to M.A. degree programme shall have 55% or above (6.0 CGPA) in B.A. in English literature / ELT / linguistics from any recognized university / college. Candidates appearing in the final year of Bachelor degree programme may also apply. Provisional admission is permitted for such candidates. Any candidate admitted provisionally shall produce the provisional / degree certificate and all mark lists in original on or before 30th September 2025. Else, their admission shall stand cancelled. For such candidates refund will be made as per the institute norms. Conversion from CGPA to percentage or vice versa given by individual institute will not be considered / allowed

- 1. Admission is based on NTA CUET-PG 2025 score in ENGLISH (LAQP01) and eligibility criteria set by NIT-T.
- 2. There is no stipend for the candidates admitted to M.A. programme.

Reservation: Government of India reservation policy will be followed for GEN-EWS, OBC-NCL, SC, ST and Persons with Disability (PwD).

In case of GEN-EWS, OBC-NCL category, the certificate must be issued on or after 1st April 2025 and should be submitted in prescribed format.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 1. Applicants must apply through the online portal https://nittadm.samarth.edu.in/ only.
- 2. Candidates should apply online and upload the requisite documents / certificates.
- 3. Applicants MUST upload the following scanned documents while submitting the Application.
 - i. Mark sheet of Class X.
 - ii. Mark sheet of Class XII.
 - iii. NTA CUET (PG) score card.
 - iv. Photo ID proof (Aadhaar) as per the Govt. of India norms.
 - v. Grade / Mark sheets of qualifying examination for all semesters.
 - vi. Degree / Provisional certificate. If the result of qualifying degree is awaited, certificate of course completion from the institute / university last studied must be provided.
- vii. Transfer Certificate issued from the institute last studied/attended.
- viii. Migration Certificate, for applicants other than Tamil Nadu candidates.
- ix. Certificate of category (GEN-EWS, OBC-NCL, SC, ST). In case of GEN-EWS, OBC-NCL category, the certificate must be issued on or after 1st April 2025. (if applicable).
- x. Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD) issued by Medical Board notified under PwD Act. (if applicable).

APPLICATION FEES:

The application fee is Rs.500/- for GEN / GEN-EWS / OBC-NCL and Rs.200/- for SC / ST / PwD candidates. The application fee is non-refundable.
