Important Instructions for Candidates Appearing for the Interview

Candidates appearing for the interview scheduled from **02:30 PM on 9th Jan 2026** are advised to reach the main entrance of NIT, Tiruchirappalli, by 02.00 PM. It takes approximately 10-20 minutes to walk from the main entrance to the concerned department. Candidates must ensure they reach the venue in time.

How to reach NIT, Tiruchirappalli? : NIT, Tiruchirappalli is located approximately 22 km from Tiruchirappalli Junction and the Central Bus Stand on the Tiruchirappalli-Thanjavur Highway. The most economical and convenient way to reach the institute is by bus. From Tiruchirappalli Junction, take any city bus to the Central Bus Stand, and then board a Thanjavur-bound mofussil or route bus. The journey typically takes around 40 minutes. Alternatively, you can hire a taxi for a more comfortable journey, which may cost between ₹500 and ₹600. Tiruchirappalli is well-connected by road to major towns in South India, including Chennai (320 km), via regular bus services. It is also a significant junction on the Southern Railway network, linking all major Indian cities. Additionally, the city has an international airport with connections to various domestic and international destinations.

Certificates: Candidates are required to bring a copy of their application submitted in the portal, a self-attested photocopy of their certificates, and a copy of their research publications. These documents can be submitted to the department before the interview. The candidates need to submit the Sponsorship Certificate if they have not submitted it earlier.

Interview: The interview will begin at 2.30 PM and will be conducted in the respective department at NIT, Tiruchirappalli.
