Important Instructions for Candidates Appearing for the Written Test

Candidates appearing for the written test, scheduled from 9:30 AM to 11:00 AM (1.5 hours), are advised to reach the main entrance of NIT, Tiruchirappalli, by 8:45 AM. It takes approximately 10-15 minutes to walk from the main entrance to the exam venue, the ORION building. Candidates must ensure they are seated in the exam hall by 9:15 AM.

How to reach NIT, Tiruchirappalli? NIT, Tiruchirappalli is located approximately 22 km from Tiruchirappalli Junction and the Central Bus Stand on the Tiruchirappalli-Thanjavur Highway. The most economical and convenient way to reach the institute is by bus. From Tiruchirappalli Junction, take any city bus to the Central Bus Stand, then board a Thanjavur-bound mofussil or route bus. The journey typically takes around 40 minutes. Alternatively, you can hire a taxi for a more comfortable journey, which may cost between ₹500 and ₹600. Tiruchirappalli is well-connected by road to major towns in South India, including Chennai (320 km), via regular bus services. It is also a significant junction on the Southern Railway network, linking all major Indian cities. Additionally, the city has an international airport with connections to various domestic and international destinations.

Certificates: Candidates are required to bring a self-attested photocopy of their certificates and a copy of their research publications. These documents can be submitted to the department after the written test and before the interview. Candidates are requested to bring a valid photo ID for verification and a call letter (email from the department) for the written test.

Interview: The interview will begin at 2:00 PM and will be conducted in the respective department at NIT, Tiruchirappalli, for shortlisted candidates based on their written test performance. Depending on the number of candidates shortlisted for a department, the interview may be extended to the next day as well. In such cases, candidates must also be prepared to attend an interview the next day.
