Instructions to the Student (in the Convention Hall)

25.07.2026 (2.00 PM to 07.00 PM)

1. All graduands shall occupy only their allotted seats in the Golden Jubilee Convention Hall (GJCH) and remain seated throughout the Convocation Ceremony.
2. Graduands shall be seated strictly in the order of their roll numbers, following the sequence of degree certificate distribution as given below:
 - Architecture: Ph.D. → M.Arch. → B.Arch.
 - Engineering Departments: Ph.D. → M.S. (By Research) → M.Tech. → B.Tech.
 - Physics: Ph.D. → M.Tech. → M.Sc.
 - Chemistry and Mathematics: Ph.D. → M.Sc.
 - Computer Applications: Ph.D. → MCA → M.Tech. → M.Sc.
 - Management Studies: Ph.D. → MBA
 - Humanities and Social Sciences: Ph.D. → M.A.
3. The graduands are requested to remain standing at their respective seats as the academic procession enters the convention hall and proceeds to the dais.
4. Graduands shall remain attentive to the programme and be prepared to receive their degree certificates when their department and programme are announced.
5. When called to receive their degree certificates, graduands shall rise from their seats and form a quick, orderly queue on the floor of the Convention Hall. Forming a queue on the dais is strictly prohibited.
6. Graduands shall proceed briskly to the centre of the dais, bow gracefully, receive their degree certificate from the Director, and return promptly to their original seats by the designated route.
7. **Medal winners shall, after receiving their degree certificates, return to and remain seated in their original seats until they are called for the medal presentation ceremony.**
8. No graduand shall leave the Convention Hall until the Academic Procession has exited the hall at the conclusion of the Convocation Ceremony.
9. All graduands are expected to maintain the dignity, discipline, and decorum of the Convocation Ceremony throughout the proceedings, until the Academic Procession has departed from the Convention Hall.
10. Movement into or out of the Convention Hall during the Convocation Ceremony is strictly prohibited, except with the prior permission of the designated officials.
11. **The use of mobile phones inside the Convention Hall is strictly prohibited throughout the Convocation Ceremony. All mobile phones shall be switched off or kept in silent mode before the commencement of the ceremony.**
12. Graduands are requested to cooperate fully with the volunteers and officials to ensure the smooth, orderly, and dignified conduct of the Convocation Ceremony.
