Symptoms of Conjunctivitis includes



- Redness of Eyes
- Discharge from Eyes in morning
- Gritty Sensation of eyes/irritation
- Pain
- Puffy Eyelids

Precautions to Contain the Spread of Conjunctivitis

- Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly with soap especially in public places
- 2. Avoid *rubbing or touching* your face /eyes
- 3. *Never share your personal Items* like towels, handkerchiefs, pillows cover
- 4. *Cover your face* when coughing or sneezing
- 5. Change your *pillow cases* often
- 6. Keep your *countertops, door knobs, sinks, faucets clean* by cleaning with antiseptic cleaner
- 7. Do not share your eye drops or eye makeup
- 8. **Stop using contact lenses** if you notice any symptoms
- Avoid close contact with others if you are symptomatic and consult doctor immediately.
