About Library

The Central Library, established in 1964, serves as the heart of academic excellence at the Institute. Its state-of-the-art hybrid library offers a vast collection of over 2.5 lakh documents, including technical books, journals, e-resources, reports, and standards. With subscriptions to 83 print journals, 13,000+ e-journals, 1,995+ e-books, and 17,690 back volumes, the library caters to diverse disciplines such as Engineering, Science, Technology, Humanities, Social Sciences, and Management. It has also developed a specialized collection for the ITEP programme. The library leverages smart technology, including RFID, for automated circulation and security. It has upgraded LIBSYS10 CLOUD LMS for library automation operations, and a modernized Digital Knowledge Centre equipped with 38 computers and AC facilities. As a member of NDLI, DELNET, and One Nation One Subscription (ONOS), it provides access to premium digital resources. To further enhance research accessibility, the library has signed an MoU with Shodhganga, enabling submission and access to Indian theses and dissertations. Its institutional membership with the DAISY Forum of India also ensures inclusive access for visually impaired users. Continuously evolving, the Central Library remains committed to fostering innovation, research, and lifelong learning.

Web Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC)

The OPAC allows for the access of bibliographic databases of books, reports, CD-ROMs and journals available in the central library. The catalogue includes a wordbased search facility using Boolean operators that can narrow down a search to meet very specific needs. Additional features of this catalogue are:

- ☐ Periodic list of recent additions to the library.
- ☐ Members can find the materials checked out to them.
- ☐ Details of the status of the books can be accessed while browsing and searching for information.

Document Delivery Services

Document Delivery Services are provided through DELNET and other libraries.

Digital Knowledge Centre

The Digital Knowledge Centre has been established to facilitate e-learning. It has been equipped with 38 personal computer systems, with Internet and Wi-Fi facilities.



CD-ROM Collection

A good collection of 3000+ CD-ROMS is available for users in the Central Library. The library has procured the McGraw-Hill Multimedia Encyclopedia of Science and Technology on CD-ROM.

BIS Corner

The BIS Corner, located at the Digital Knowledge Centre, Central Library of NITT, will provide access to information on Indian standards, handbooks, and technical literature, enabling students and faculty to familiarise themselves with the frameworks that underpin quality, interoperability and safety.



Audio Visual Section

The Audio-Visual section is equipped with a microfilm reader, audio cassette players, video cassette recorders and over 1500 educational audio and video cassettes. Students use therecord players and computers for preparing for the TOEFL and GRE examinations.

Sugamya Pustakalaya

Sugamya Pustakalaya, www.sugamyapustakalaya.org.in is a facilitating platform for producers of accessible content to jointly work in producing and providing accessible books to people with print disabilities. Here, you can access books in diverse languages from various libraries across India. They have also partnered with international agencies like Bookshare and Accessible Books Consortium to provide you with accessible books from all over the world.

CCTV-Web Camera Surveillance

CCTV network cameras have been installed in all the entrances and stacks to avoid book theft and other malpractices. The entire building is under CCTV camera surveillance.

Book Bank Scheme

There is a separate Book Bank Section with a collection of more than 17,500+ textbooksfor the reserved category students. A maximum of 5 Book Bank Books will be issued to each eligible SC/ST post-matric scholars and rank holders per semester for promoting their studies.

There is an option to "Set Password" in that mail. Click on the option. It will open a new tab and will ask you to create a password.

Plagiarism Detection Software

• Turnitin

Turnitin is an Internet-based plagiarism detection service. You can generate a similarity report of your research article, assignment and project reports. Only Faculty members and Group A officers get an instructor account to visit the Library or send a request mail to librarian@nitt.edu. Research scholars and students may approach their respective guides to have the research scholar/student account.

Drillbit-Extreme Similarity Checking Tool

Drillbit-Extreme is globally recognised as a plagiarism detection tool. Faculty members and research scholars are using this tool for the creation of original Academic Content. To have an Ouriginal account, send an email request to librarian@nitt.edu. Before submitting any article/ research paper to Ouriginal, go through the instructions and submission guidelines carefully.

Academic Writing Tool

• Grammarly

Grammarly is an application tool for checking spelling and grammar for research writing. It automatically detects potential issues in the text/ document and suggests context-specific corrections for grammar, spelling, punctuation, word choice, style, and plagiarism. To get all the features, users need to sign up with their institutional email ID.

Shodhganga - Indian Electronic Theses and Dissertations Repository

Shodhganga is the Indian national repository of electronic theses and dissertations deposited by most of the Indian universities. It is a repository of electronic versions of synopses/research proposals submitted to universities for registration in a PhD. Shodhganga stands for the reservoir of Indian intellectual output stored in a repository hosted and maintained by the Centre. It is set up using an open-source digital repository software. Currently, we have uploaded the theses of the researchers awarded in the year 2025.



Library Rules and Regulations

- 1. The students/scholars and outsiders entering the Library shall deposit their bags and other belongings at the entrance and sign in the Register at the checkpoint.
- 2. Only notebooks and the Library books to be returned will be allowed inside.
- 3. The students/scholars are advised not to leave their valuables at the Check Point.

 The library is not responsible for any loss of personal belongings.
- 4. All belongings such as files, books and notebooks must be presented to the security guard at the checkpoint for inspection while leaving the Library. The library does not permit any exception to the observance of this rule.
- 5. An ID Card should be compulsory for entering the library.
- 6. Borrowed books & other documents should be protected from rain, dust, insects, etc.
- 7. Books removed from the shelves by students, if not required for reference, should be kept on the book trolley or on the table nearest to them. Please do not try to shelve them yourself. Please remember that a book misplaced is a book lost.
- 8. Students/Scholars are advised not to issue Books to others in their names. Reference Documents like dictionaries, encyclopedias, yearbooks, Journals (Loose & Bound), Theses, Project Reports, censuses, and Handbooks will not be issued.
- 9. Conversation and discussion disturb the library's ambience. Therefore, all are

- requested to maintain dignified silence.
- 10. Beverages and Eatables are not allowed inside the library.
- 11. No visitor or guest is permitted to use the Library without the prior permission of the Librarian. He/She is required to produce a proper introduction letter from the concerned Institution/Organization to which he/she is attached.
- 12. Using Cell Phones inside the Library premises should be avoided.
- 13. No photograph of the Library shall be taken without the prior permission of the Librarian.
- 14. Students/Scholars are advised to come to the Library in decent dress as they do in the classrooms. Wearing Bermuda & strip tops is not allowed in the Library.
- 15. All the users of the Library will be provided with an Online Membership to utilise the Library facilities and services.
- 16. Bags, Big handbags, Raincoats, jackets and Casual wear are strictly prohibited inside the library.
- 17. Members are requested to keep their belongings at the entrance of the Library. However, they are advised not to leave cell phones, purses, money, credit cards and other valuables in the handbag outside the library. These items are liable to be lost.
- 18. Library users are strictly prohibited from taking their own Books & spiral-bound books, borrowed and stamped books, again inside the library
- 19. The books should be returned on or before the due date, marked on the date label.
- 20. A penalty of ONE RUPEE will be charged per day after the due date for books.
- 21. Absence from the Institute will not be allowed as an excuse for the delay in the return of books.
- 22. Books will be issued only against the production of the User's Identity Card.
- 23. The Library will be closed on the National holidays.
- 24. Students and Staff who leave the Institute for any reason should surrender all the Library Books before they leave the Institute.
- 25. Students indulging in unhealthy practices such as stealing Library documents, tearing or damaging the documents will be severely punished.
- 26. Writing or underlining in a book or tampering with a book in any manner is strictly prohibited.
- 27. Under special circumstances, the Librarian may refuse the issue of books or recall

the books already issued to any member without assigning any reason thereof.

- 28. The Following conditions are to be followed for the renewal of books.
- i. The book has to be physically produced in the Library for renewal.
- ii. Identity Card should be produced/shown to the counter staff
- iii. No remainders will be issued to individuals, but a consolidated list of defaulters will be displayed in the library.
- 29. For loss of Library Books, the user has to replace it with a brand new book with the same ISBN or remit double the original purchase cost of the book. If the Book lost belongs to a set of multi-volume books, the cost of the entire set of volumes will be recovered from the borrower.
- 30. RFID Tags have been pasted on the Books. If the Tag is found torn/damaged or lost when used by the borrower, a token fine of Rs. 500/- will be charged for the same.
