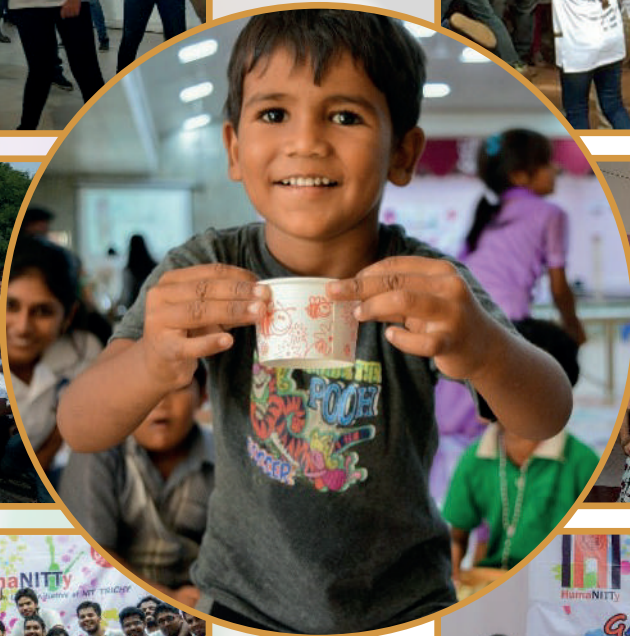
SOCIAL INITIATIVES
